<u>The Growth Rate Chart</u> - what to consider and know when you select a woody plant. (Excerpt from an American Conifer Society article by Chris Daeger)

<u>Miniatures</u> - these grow 1 inch or less per year. Yep, that means the 3" x 3" plant you have in your hand will be no larger than 13" x 13" in ten years, (unless you really were nice to it, and fed it; but then again, for the latter, why would you?)

<u>Dwarfs</u> - these grow one to six inches per year. You can do the math now can't you? Personally I divide this category on a plant by plant basis since it can range tremendously when it comes to smaller type plants and their propensity to be wanted or placed in smaller areas. I loved showing 80 year old dwarf conifers at the Rowe Arboretum that indeed were 40' tall.

<u>Intermediates</u> - woody plants that grow 6 to 12" per year. Give 'em some room for crying out loud! Think of the 70 year old intermediates that exist in some older collections. Again, we are talking some serious shade makers.

<u>Large</u>- if they grow more than a foot per year, they can be listed here. You know the types-white pines, dawn-redwoods, oaks, maples, invasive Asian honeysuckle, etc. These are the ones that anyone of us can plant and never see them reach their limits in height alone. It is because they usually don't do that until they reached the genetic limitations within their own hydraulic capabilities to pump water and nutrients up to their tops. At that point they just spread wider; sounds like us, doesn't it?

So, considerations must be made and need to be asked by the one who is to ultimately take charge of any plant, which is usually bound and determined to keep on growing no matter what you say or do or wish. Only you can answer the question in your mind on where you are going to plant your goodie, and when if ever you are going to have to deal with it beyond just enjoying it for what it is.
